*Local Transportation:*

Public transportation is free within a Fareless Square downtown. Attendees staying at other hotels can easily access the PSU campus by using the bus or Streetcar for free.

*Parking:*

Overnight parking for guests of the University Place Hotel is available for \$12 per night. Those staying at other hotels should consider leaving their cars at their hotels and using the free downtown public transportation to reach the PSU campus.

We strongly encourage local attendees to use public transportation. Parking on the PSU campus can be extremely tight. PSU does offer some daily parking on a limited availability basis.
